**IMPORTANT ELECTION INFORMATION**

**To Voters in Shenandoah County who believe they have registered to vote or made name/address changes to their current voter registration at the DMV (Department of Motor Vehicles):**

DMV does not register people to vote. DMV only offers and accepts the voter registration applications. You are NOT registered to vote and NO CHANGES have been made to your current voter registration until the application or change has been approved and processed by your Voter Registrar. If the application is approved and processed, you will receive a voter registration card with your current name, address and polling place. Check now! Do you have a voter registration card that contains the CURRENT correct information? If not, contact the Registrar. By law, you must be properly registered in the correct precinct 29 days before each election in order to be eligible to vote in the election.

If you have submitted an application through DMV and have not received a voter registration card, Shenandoah County residents should call 540-459-6195 before the deadline. Any new registrations or changes received after the deadline will be held and processed after the election.
